
## **INTERACTIVE TABLE OF CONTENTS:** BLUE MEANS LINK

When you open an ERIS Database Report, the first page is more than a Table of Contents; it's an interactive guide to help you navigate the entire document. In short, **anywhere you see** BLUE TYPE, **it means that word or phrase is linked** to another page or section. Below are some examples of how these links work.
