



## ADOBE NAVIGATION PANE: BUILT-IN SHORTCUTS

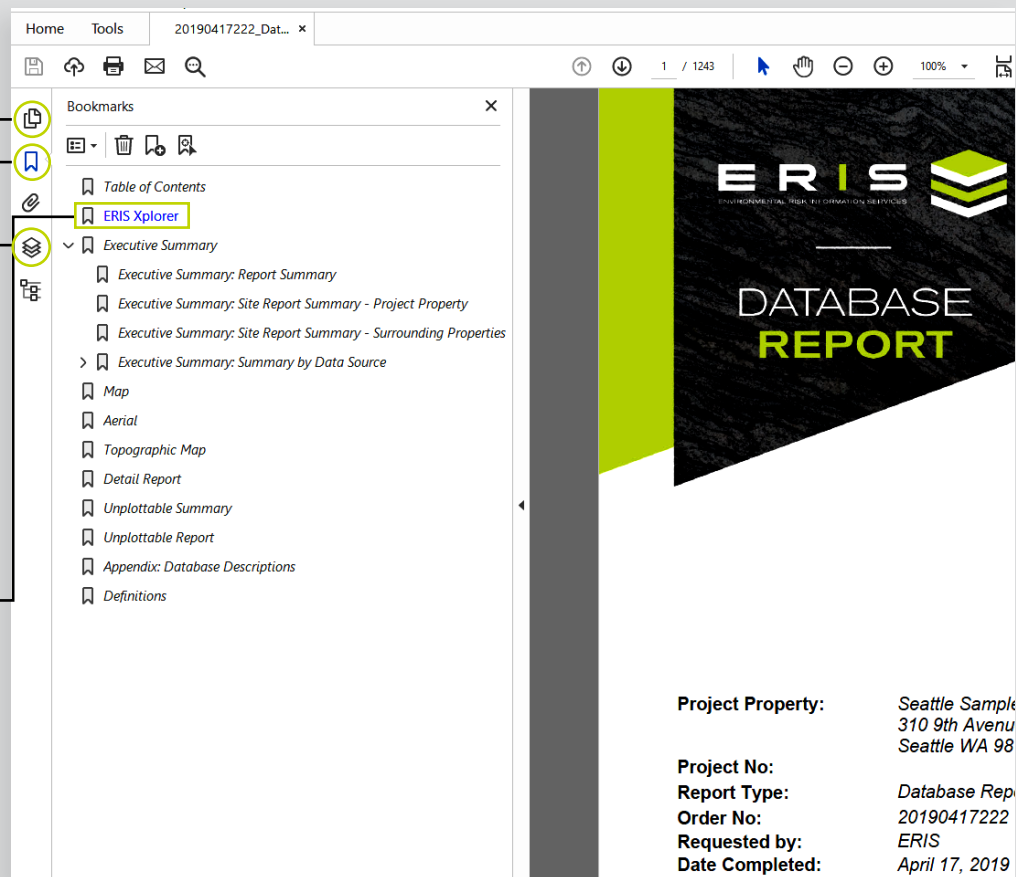
When you open up an ERIS Database Report in Adobe, here are three simple tips on how to navigate the document more easily: open the Navigation Pane on the left and click on the icons to view PAGES as thumbnails, BOOKMARKS to jump to specific sections, and LAYERS when viewing maps.

**PAGES** allow you to view each page as a thumbnail and select the one you want to view. It's like looking through a printed report.

**BOOKMARKS** organize each section of the report like an outline, essentially creating an interactive Table of Contents you can see no matter where you are in the document. You can go directly to the section of your choice, and access the details and interactive links within each one. Click back and forth instead of scrolling through the entire report.

**TIP:** The ERIS Xplorer tool can be accessed by clicking on the 'ERIS Xplorer' link. ERIS Xplorer is a powerful, interactive tool for overlaying and analyzing data and historical images.

**LAYERS** allow you to select what you want turned on or off within the maps provided.
